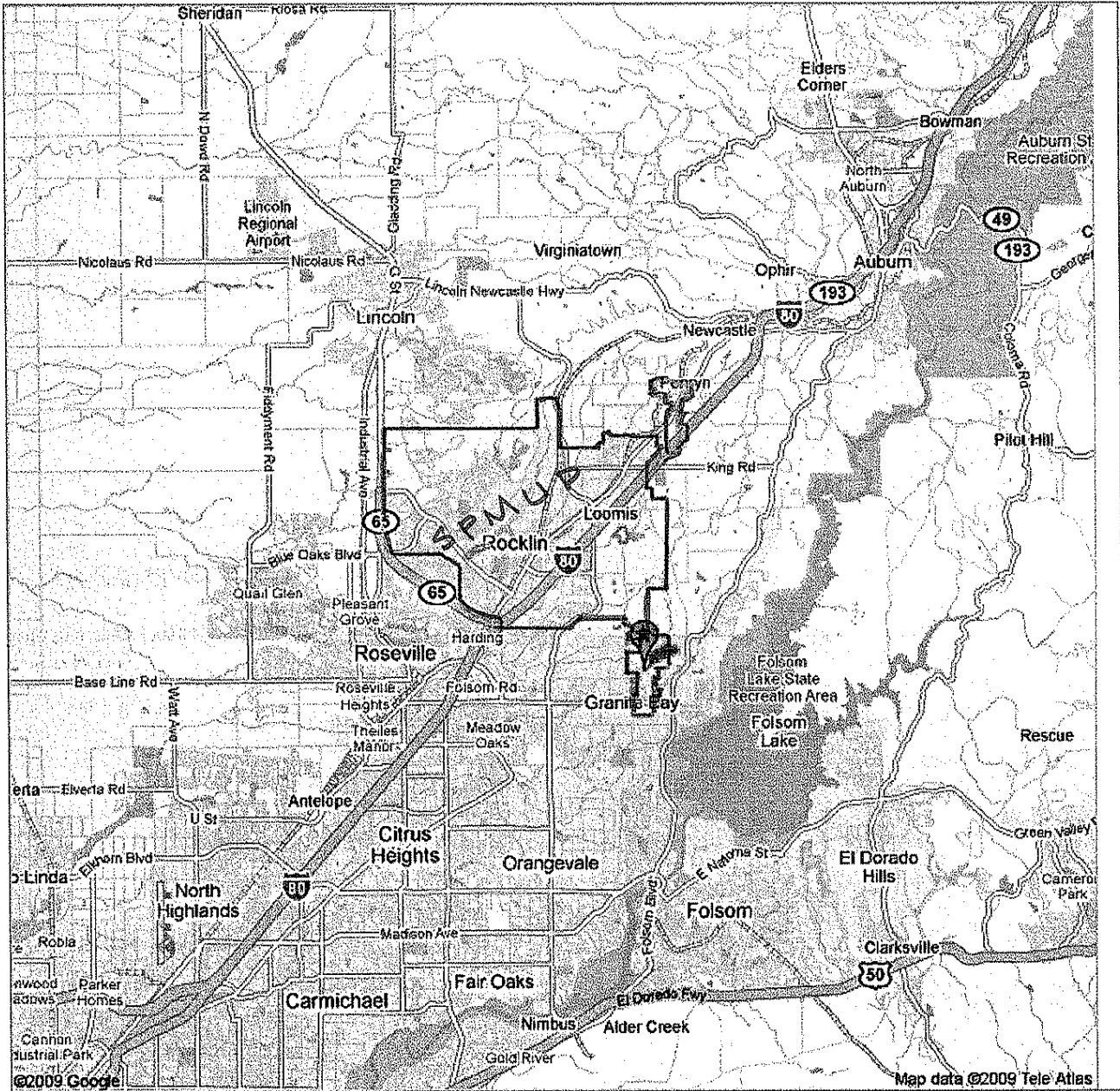

RESOLUTION NO. 09-04

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A FEE SCHEDULE
FOR SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, South Placer Municipal Utility District has conducted an analysis of its services, the costs reasonably borne, the beneficiaries of those services, and the revenues produced by those paying fees and charges for administrative and other special services; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to establish a policy of recovering the costs reasonably borne of providing administrative and other special services of a voluntary and/or limited nature, such that service charges are not diverted from general services of a broad nature and thereby utilized to subsidize unfairly and inequitably such administrative and other special services; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board to develop a schedule of fees and charges based on the District's budgeted and projected costs reasonably borne.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of South Placer Municipal Utility District as follows:

Section 1

The schedule of fees and charges, as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, are hereby fixed and established, and are to be collected by the District for the listed services when provided by the District. The General Manager may provide for a waiver or adjustment in the fees when such waiver or adjustment is determined to be in the public interest.

Section 2

The fees set by this resolution are for the specified services listed. For any additional services provided, the cost of which is indeterminate and not included in the fee schedule, the General Manager may estimate the time required to provide the service and require payment of a fee at the fully burdened District hourly bill-out-rate.

Section 3

The Board hereby finds and determines that the fees imposed by this resolution are necessary to cover the costs of providing the specified services, and that such fees do not exceed the reasonable costs of providing said services.

Section 4

The fees and charges for administrative and other special services that have been established by prior resolutions, ordinances, and other actions of the Board that are inconsistent with this resolution are hereby repealed.

Section 5

The fees and charges shown on the fee schedule, not otherwise fixed and established by separate ordinance or resolution, shall be adjusted by the General Manager on the 1st of July of each fiscal year based on the prior fiscal year Revised Budget for projected expenses plus total transfers, as distributed over the District's workforce and total available work hours per year, unless otherwise determined by the Board.

Section 6
